

# Mon Ami delivered at Skipper Expo Int Aberdeen

A trip to the Skipper Expo in Bournemouth resulted in 2 Scotsmen collecting their new 7 mtr potting boat at the Skipper Expo in Aberdeen 6 months later.

John Smith and David Wood of JWS Fishing were looking for a new fast potter and after meeting Stephen Rees of Robust Boats at the show and checking out the Robust 23c on display, they placed an order.

The new vessel named "Mon Ami" was displayed at the Robust Boats stand at Aberdeen complete with new twin Selva Murina 25XS Outboards.

The Robust 23c has a LOA of 6.95 mtrs with a 2.45 mtr beam and a draught of just 0.4 mtrs. it is designed to cruise at speeds of up to 25 knots with the right power package.

Mon Ami is equipped with a 0.5t pot hauler manufactured by Solent Engineering powered by a 8hp Honda Power Pack and a

wheelhouse electronics package supplied and fitted by Echomaster Marine that includes: 1 x Olex 3D Ground Mapping Chartplotter with Neovo X17 Monitor, 1 x Hondex HE-881 8.4" Colour Echosounder with 600W Bronze Transducer, 1 x Konden KGP-913MKII GPS Navigator and 1 x Icom IC-M323G

DSC VHF with built in GPS Receiver.

The Olex 3D Chart system provides a unique combination of navigation, fishery plotting and seafloor mapping. Using data from a ship's own Echosounder and GPS, the Olex system collects real-time

data about the seafloor, building into a realistic seafloor view. It has both 3D and 2D Modes allowing for a clear understanding of the topography of the area.

Robust Boats will have a Robust 17c 5.2 mtr on display at the upcoming Skipper Expo Int. Bristol.
